HCC HOUSEHOLD WASTE RECYCLING CENTRES – New Review 2016.

- New contract commenced on 1st April 2016 to Veolia.
- HWRC Services Efficiencies Programme Savings target £1.55 million
- New consultation now completed with 11,497 responses, 137 letters & 5 formal petitions. The results are:-
- Current Summer Opening: 0900-1800 hrs to be 1100-1800 hrs.
- Current Winter Opening: 0900-1600 hrs to be 1100-1600 hrs.
- All sites will close on Thursday (least used day).
- £2 charge for non-Hampshire residents. Charges for non-household waste.
- Changes to start from January 2017.
