How does Switch Hampshire work?

The scheme combines everyone who registers in an auction with the energy suppliers. The suppliers bid against each other and the one offering the lowest tariff wins the auction.

After the auction, the scheme lets you know how much you could save if you switched to the winning tariff. If you decide to switch, the whole process will be managed for you by the scheme.

Why should I register?

- It's a safe council-backed scheme
- Registration is simple, free and no obligation
- It can show you whether you're currently on a good deal or whether you could save if you switched
- Takes the hassle out of switching
- You get a fixed price contract for at least a year
- The scheme covers gas, electricity and pre-payment meters

How do I register?

- To register you'll need your tariff and energy useage (either in £s or Kwhs) from your annual energy statement.
